

**2023 GOALS & OBJECTIVES

We look forward to another successful year in 2023 with things getting back to normal after the COVID-19 Pandemic. Our focus will remain excellent customer service and sound financial stewardship, keeping taxes low while providing high quality service to our residents and businesses. We anticipate completing a number of important projects during the coming year to improve our community.

The following is a list of Goals and Objectives for 2023:

1. Continue work with KYTC and their consultant to address the traffic congestion on Turkeyfoot Road and Thomas More Parkway, encouraging solutions that are the least disruptive to the community. Lobby our state elected officials for construction funding of the project in future budget cycles.
2. Continue ongoing efforts to rebuild older City Streets, including those in Thomas More Office Park. Implement advice provided by our engineering consultant on current conditions and plans for future street replacement and maintenance.
3. Continue to work with Duke Energy on upgrading streetlights to more efficient LED lights.
4. Complete Phase 2 of the Centre View Park Improvements and Shelter installation.
5. Work with Thomas More University as they continue to update their campus for students and athletes.
6. Complete conversion of Thomas More Parkway streetlights to LED lighting.
7. Create incentive package to recruit small businesses to the Thomas More Office Park, as recommended by the 2021 Economic Development Policy Initiatives.
8. Study the feasibility of a hotel in Crestview Hills, as recommended by the 2021 Economic Development Policy Initiatives.
9. Explore installing a sidewalk network abutting the lakes in Old Crestview Hills as part of upcoming street improvements.
10. Explore expansion of the City Building to accommodate the office and storage needs of both the City Public Works/Administration and the Police Department.
11. Maintain the highest level of professionalism in City Government and continue to enhance the community's reputation as a prime destination for businesses and residents.

I look forward to working with the City Council, City Staff, businesses and residents in the coming year to achieve these objectives.
